### **Website and Social Media**

## **Attendance and Punctuality**

Please, ensure that your child attends school and arrives in time and also that they have everything that they need while at school. If a person has contact with someone who has tested positive, they must isolate for 10 days.

## **School Bus Service**

Related to the issue of punctuality is the issue of the school bus service that the school has introduced. The bus service was introduced following the late arrival of many students because of transport problems currently faced in Kadoma. At the moment the service has been temporarily halted to allow parents make the payments of 20 USD per month. Services will resume on the second term opening day 03 May 2022. The pick up and drop off points would be as follows: Rimuka ( Machipisa Traffic Circle, Game park, Post Office and Methodist Church), Ingezi, Pixie Combie and Patchway.

The parents and guardians are kindly urged to make payments before the third of May so that bus services resume on this particular day.

# **April School Holiday Classes**

As was announced in the Annual General Meeting held on 18 March 2022, there is going to be compulsory online and in person classes for form four and form six students from 19 April to 29 April. During the said period, students will be engaged in doing CALA. Thus, it is a must that all the forth formers and sixth formers be in attendance. Dressing will be strictly complete school uniform. Lessons start at 0800 HRS – 1300 HRS. A mandatory online fee of 20 USD is required per child.

## **School Fees Payment**

With the exception of only a few, the majority of the parents and guardians managed to meet their financial obligations for the first term in full. That is quite commendable. Note that school fees should be paid in full on or before the opening day of each term.
